Attendees from WNY schools took part in presentations and workshops that addressed various aspects of STEAM education, including: technology integration, inquiry learning and more.

Forty-two middle school students attended one of two week-long Summer STEAM Experiences hosted by Nardin Academy and St. Joseph's Collegiate Institute. Students explored robots at the Battling Bots Experience, by building their own battle bots in teams while also traveling to various WNY sites such as the General Motors Powertrain Plant.
