Description:

In "Are You Healthy: Sports Science", students will get an up close and personal look at the science and math behind some of their favorite sports and the preparation it takes to fuel the body for competition. The week will consist of several field trips throughout WNY, including Impact Sports at Harbor Center where we will get an in depth look at the science of hockey from both a physical and nutritional standpoint.

Description:

This one-week session teaches students how the disciplines found within STEAM combine so engineers can build the bridges we use every day. In addition to learning basic bridge math and design concepts, the students will use computer software to design their own bridges virtually, and then will have a chance to build their own bridge from Balsa wood! Once completed, the different bridges will compete in a contest to see who designed the STRONGEST bridge!
