 Times: 9:00 a.m.—3:00 p.m. (Extended care available from 7:30 to 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 to 4:30 p.m. daily)

Arrival/Departure times are 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., respectively. Scholars must arrive at The Park School circle off Harlem Road by 9:00 a.m. and be picked up at the same area at 3:00 p.m. Scholars will not be allowed to leave the campus unless accompanied by a specified parent/guardian. Please be prepared to show ID upon request. Extended day ends promptly at 4:30 p.m.

Appropriate clothing must be worn. All clothing should be labeled with the scholar's name. Most programs include a daily swim. Scholars are required to bring proper swimwear and towels.

Lunch is included. A lunch menu will be provided. Any campers not wishing to utilize the lunch provided can bring a bag lunch. If your child has any special dietary needs, we ask that you provide your child with a snack from home and inform us of specific food restrictions.

MESSY, SLOPPY ART For students ages 4 – 6 Molly Drozda, Faculty

This is a week-long creative adventure for your young artist! Campers will use the world around them, the Park Campus and nature, and their imaginations to inspire ideas. The group will use clay, paint, mixed media, and a variety of drawing materials to create pieces of art such as pots, sculptures, paintings, comics, and much more!

Cooking, baking, freezing, frying and blending are all a part of this fun, hands on camp. Campers are encouraged to bring ideas and recipes of foods they are interested in making and we will try to make as many as possible. Each day there will be a counselor directed cooking activity in addition to what the campers choose to make. Be prepared for a week full of fun and food!

For the young theatre enthusiast! Scholars will discover how to use theatre techniques to enhance their interpersonal skills and engage in activities that will encourage them to be creative and use their imaginations. Scholars will write, direct, and act in their final performance!
